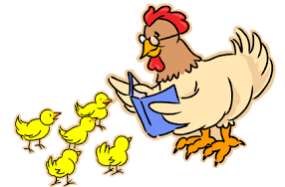

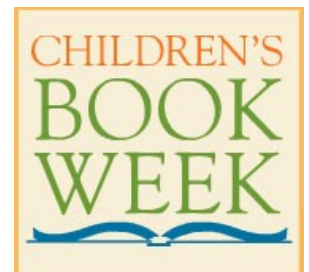


CHILDREN'S BOOK WEEK

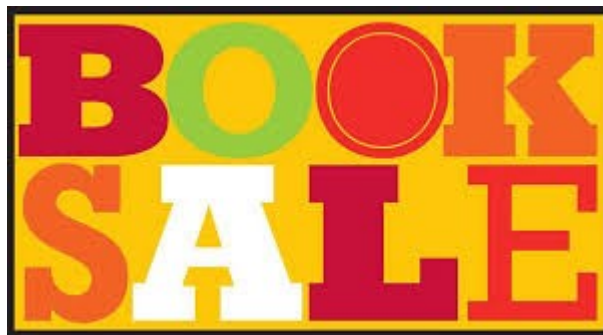


SIDEWALK BOOK SALE

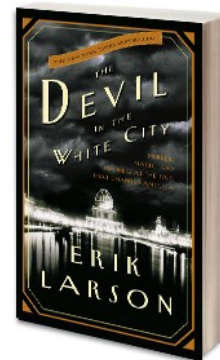
