

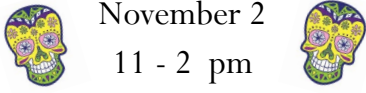

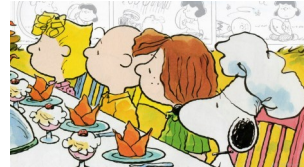
Election Day is Tuesday, November 5.

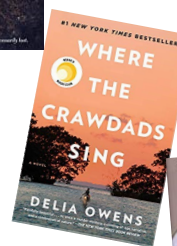
