

This story features Grace Munroe, a young, well educated housewife. Grace and her husband have gone through challenges trying to start a family, and have grown apart. At the time she suspects him of infidelity, she receives a mysterious letter from Paris that contains plane tickets and an urgent request for her presence. Grace struggles with whether to go off to Paris to address business from an unknown relative, or to stay and try to repair her marriage. She takes the plunge and is off to France on a cultural and historical journey, where she learns more about her past than she could imagine. 


